Cuba qualifies to Rio 2016 in Men's Beach Volleyball

SAN CARLOS, Nuevo Guaymas, Mexico, June 26, 2016 – Cuba conquered the finals of the Norceca Beach Volleyball Men's Continental Cup and claimed the ticket to the Olympic Games of Rio de Janeiro 2016.

Despite a 2-1 (20-22, 21-17, 15-11) first victory by Canadians Josh Binstock and Sam Schachter over Karel Peña and Daisel Quesada, Cuba won the series 3-1.

Sergio Gonzalez and Nivaldo Díaz defeated Sam Pedlow and Grant O'Gorman 2-0 (21-18, 21-18) and also did it against Binstock and Schachter (24-22, 21-18). Peña and Quesada took the fourth one over Pedlow and O'Gorman (21-17, 21-13) to grant the Olympic ticket.

"We are at the Olympics. This was a great tournament for us, and I dedicate it to all the people in Cuba. Thanks to Mexico for the support," said Daisel Quesada after the Awards Ceremony. "We feel so glad for this, we have been practicing hard as we held some training camps in Mexico before the final stage of the Continental Cup," remarked Cuban coach Leonides Regueiferos.

Mexico finished with the bronze medal when the series were decided in a golden set. Josue Gaxiola and Jose Luis Rubio defeated Hector Soto and Juan Carlos Ribas 15-9. Previously the same Soto had played along with Kevin Rodriguez in the first match of the series to win against Juan Revuelta and Ricardo Galindo in three sets by scores of 15-21, 21-14 and 15-13.

Gaxiola and Rubio tied the series to 1 after beating Fernando Morales and Juan Carlos Ribas by scores of 21-13 and 21-15 and later on won against Soto and Rodriguez in three (15-21, 21-14, 15-13), however, Puerto Rico with Soto and Rivas, triumphed in fourth match by winning 21-18 and 21-15, so the series were even 2-2.

For Gaxiola and Rubio this was another epic battle. The Silver Medal winners of the last U21 World Championship showed their quality on the sand and are still with the hopes alive of becoming the second Mexican couple looking for a ticket to Rio.

Cuba clasifica a Rio 2016 en voleibol de playa masculino

SAN CARLOS, Nuevo Guaymas, México, Junio 26, 2016 – Cuba conquistó la medalla de oro en las finales de la Copa Continental de Voleibol Masculino de la Confederación Norceca y obtuvo el boleto a los Juegos Olímpicos de Río de Janeiro 2016.

A pesar de una primera victoria por 2-1 (20-22, 21-17, 15-11) por parte de los canadienses Josh Binstock y Sam Schachter sobre Karell Peña y Daisel Quesada, Cuba ganó la serie 3-1.

Sergio Gonzalez y Nivaldo Díaz derrotaron a Sam Pedlow y Grant O’Gorman 2-0 (21-18, 21-18) y de igual forma lo hicieron contra Binstock y Schachter (24-22, 21-18). Peña y Quesada se llevarían el cuarto sobre Pedlow y O’Gorman (21-17, 21-13) para garantizar el boleto olímpico.

“Estamos ya en los Juegos Olímpicos, este ha sido un gran torneo para nosotros y queremos dedicarlo a toda la gente en Cuba. Gracias a México por el apoyo”, dijo Daisel Quesada después de la ceremonia de premiación.

“Nos sentimos muy contentos por esto, hemos trabajado y entrenado fuerte al sostener algunos campamentos de entrenamiento en México antes de la fase final de la Copa Continental”, remarcó el entrenador Cubano Leonides Regueiferos.

México finalizó con la medalla de bronce y con la serie decidida en set de oro. Josué Gaxiola y José Luis Rubio derrotaron a Héctor Soto y Juan Carlos Ribas 15-9. Previamente, el propio Soto había jugado junto con Kevin Rodriguez en el primer encuentro de la serie que ganaron ante Juan Revuelta y Ricardo Galindo en tres sets por parciales de 15-21, 21-14 y 15-13.

Gaxiola y Rubio empataron la serie a 1, luego de vencer Fernando Morales y Juan Carlos por 21-13 y 21-15. Más adelante ganaron en contra de Soto y Rodriguez en tres (15-21, 21-14, 15-13), sin embargo,

Puerto Rico, con Soto y Ribas, empataron la contienda al ganar el cuarto por 21-18 y 21-15, con lo que la serie se había igualado 2-2.

Para Gaxiola ay Rubio esta fue otra épica batalla. Los ganadores de la medalla de plata del pasado Mundial Sub 21 mostraron su calidad en la arena y todavía mantienen vivas las esperanzas de convertirse en el segundo equipo varonil mexicano en busca de un boleto a Río.
