Listos para iniciar Centroamericano Sub 19

Managua, 28 de octubre de 2019. El XIII Campeonato Centroamericano Sub 19 de voleibol masculino iniciará este martes 29 de octubre en el Polideportivo Alexis Argüello de esta ciudad y los entrenadores de cada una de las selecciones esperan un torneo muy parejo, pero sobre todo resaltan la importancia de esta categoría que marca el inicio del camino en selecciones nacionales de la mayoría de los jugadores.

Dany Calderón, Entrenador de El Salvador: "Es un grupo que está bien animado, son nuevos todos, tenemos tres meses de trabajar con ellos, no hemos podido tenerlos a tiempo completo, porque todavía no tienen el compromiso creado como atleta de Selección Nacional y hay que crearles ese compromiso. Algunos toman la responsabilidad y pretenden pasarla a los demás. Como todos pretendemos estar en el podium, pero sobre todo que los muchachos la disfruten, que empiecen a hacer lazos de amistad, esa es la ganancia más grande que dejan estos torneos".

Miguel Pagoaga, asistente de Honduras: "Venimos con un equipo muy joven, esperando tener buenos resultados con las dificultades que representan los niños en formación. Tenemos proyectado estar entre los mejores cuatro, esa es nuestra meta. Es un trabajo base para el próximo Centroamericano Sub 21, ya que este grupo se quedará trabajando para un objetivo mayor en ese torneo".

Osman Hernández, entrenador de Nicaragua: "Esperamos que los muchachos se motiven por estar jugando en casa, trataremos de dar buenos partidos y quedar en el podium. De nuestro grupo ninguno ha estado en un evento internacional, apenas ayer (domingo) hicimos un fogueo ante Belice y esperamos que logren dominar la presión de ser anfitriones".

Alberto Blanco, entrenador de Costa Rica: "Costa Rica viene de ser bicampeón Centroamericano en esta categoría, venimos por el tricampeonato. Los muchachos por su edad pueden tener muchos altibajos, pero hemos tratado de hacer énfasis que aun sean niños de 14-16 años, tienen que trabajar fuerte y ser profesionales. Hay muchos países vienen subiendo y tenemos que inculcar un trabajo responsable que nos lleve más allá de la región".

Luis Fernando Castañeda, entrenador de Guatemala: "Los muchachos vienen motivados, hemos trabajado bastante para la competencia, algunos estuvieron en el Sub 21 de El Salvador y eso nos sirvió de motivación para este equipo. Nos enfocamos en cada partido diario y queremos hacer un buen torneo, la competencia será muy dura, pareja, que es lo que se ha visto en los últimos años".

Albert Humes, entrenador de Belice: "Este torneo es difícil para nosotros, no logramos completar un gran equipo porque tenemos escuela en estos momentos y eso generó presión en los muchacho. Ellos entrenaron fuerte y pensamos que podemos hacer algo bueno. Estos torneos son muy importantes porque estamos viendo a los jugadores del futuro, vemos a los talentos que están en programas de desarrollo.

Ready to start the Central American U19

Managua, October 28, 2019. The XIII U19 Central American Men's Volleyball Championship will begin this Tuesday, October 29 at the Alexis Argüello Sports Center in this city and the coaches of each of the teams expect a very even tournament, but above all they stand out the importance of this category that marks the beginning of the road in national teams of most players.

Dany Calderón, Coach of El Salvador: "It is a group that is very lively, they are all new, we have three months of working with them, we have not been able to have them full time, because they still do not have the commitment created as a National Team athlete, you have to create that commitment. Some take responsibility and pretend to pass it on to others. Like we all pretend to be on the podium, but the important thing is for the boys to enjoy, to start making friendship ties, that is the biggest gain that leave these tournaments".

Miguel Pagoaga, assistant from Honduras: "We come with a very young team, hoping to have good results with the difficulties that children in formation represent. We plan to be among the best four, that is our goal. It is a base job for the next Central American Sub 21, since this group will be working for a major goal in that tournament".

Osman Hernández, coach of Nicaragua: "We hope that the boys are motivated to be playing at home, we will try to play good games and stay on the podium. Of our group none has been in an international event, just yesterday (Sunday) we made a fire before Belize and we hope that they will dominate the pressure of being hosts".

Alberto Blanco, coach of Costa Rica: "Costa Rica comes from being a two-time Central American champion in this category, we come for the three-time championship. The boys by their age can have many ups and downs, but we have tried to emphasize that even if they are children of 14-16 years, they have to work hard and be professional. There are many countries that are coming up and we have to instill responsible work that takes us beyond the region".

Luis Fernando Castañeda, coach of Guatemala: "The boys are motivated, we have worked hard for the competition, some were in the Under 21 of El Salvador and that served as motivation for this team. We focus on each daily game and we want to make a good tournament, the competition will be very tough, couple, which is what has been seen in recent years".

Albert Humes, coach of Belize: "This tournament is difficult for us, we failed to complete a great team because we have school right now and that generated pressure on the boys. They trained hard and we thought we can do something good; These tournaments are very good; important because we are seeing the players of the future, we see the talents that are in development programs".
